

- Welcome, and thank you all for being here in Edinburgh



 - a new customer to both HPE and to NonStop, implementing a new ACI Base24 EPS environment







- 16 Customers signed NonStop as an HPE Greenlake consumption-based model







HPE Greenlake for NonStop with Flexible Cores

- An additional way of offering NonStop through HPE GreenLake with ultimate flexibility
 - Fully flexible Core choice throughout the GreenLake term
 - To be available on High End Converged NonStop and High End Virtualised NonStop
 - Removes restrictions on Core Enablement, Supports core changes 2c -> 4c, 4c -> 6c or 2c -> 6c
 - Variable Greenlake monthly billing based on actual cores used
 - Billing from Greenlake Cloud Platform – **Work in progress**
 - Utilises NonStop Metering Tool (NSMT)* on the NonStop to track Unit of Measure (UoM)
 - UoM is the core count
 - Measurement period - **Work in progress**
- A Complimentary HPE Greenlake for NonStop offering - does not replace existing options
